Court Reservations

- Courts 1 & 2 are Teaching courts
 - Courts 3 & 4 are Walk-Up courts. First come, first serve basis for members and guests.
 - Courts 5 & 6 are Advanced Reservation courts for members and for guests that have prepaid.
- 1) Singles are guaranteed 45 minutes of playing time. Doubles are guaranteed 1.5 hours of playing time. Members and guests may stay on their court until they get bumped. If they get bumped before finishing their match, they may ask for a vacant court or the next available court.
 - 2) Advanced reservations for courts 5 & 6 may be done up to two days in advance by email, telephone, or in person no earlier than 8:30am on the day of the request.
 - 3) All players must check in with the Club Director or staff to claim their assigned court. Specific court assignments are made at the discretion of the Club Director or staff. Guest fees must be paid at this time. Courts not claimed by 10 minutes after the reserved starting time will be defaulted.
 - 4) Members may not reserve courts for guests.
 - 5) Members, or players in the same group, may not make multiple court reservations when people are waiting and courts are at full capacity.
 - 6) One player may not keep a court when courts are full with people waiting.
 - 7) Members, or players in the same group, may not make consecutive court reservations before their allotted time has expired.

Guest Passes

Daily Guest Fee \$8.00 per person

Miscellaneous

- In order to best serve all of our members and guests, the club must reserve the right to manage court time to maximize court utilization.
- Officially scheduled club activities have priority over general use.
- Members must lock court gate when leaving during non-monitored hours.
- Players, upon expiration of their allotted court time, may request an extension of playing time by checking with the Club Director or staff on availability.
- In the event that rain prevents play on a court where guest fees have been paid, such fees will be refunded.
